

DIRECTIONS TO ELLEY-LONG MUSIC CENTER 223 ETHAN ALLEN AVE., COLCHESTER, VT

FROM THE NORTH: I-89 South to Exit 16. *Right off ramp onto Route 7 South (Main Street to downtown Winooski). Go 1 mile. At intersection of Route 15/Allen St. (near Post Office, Key Bank), go straight, then turn left onto new traffic circle (hopefully, there are signs pointing you to Route 15 East). Continue on circle but in right lane, passing the right-hand turnoff for the Champlain Mill, and then taking a RIGHT at the Y intersection onto Route 15 East (there IS a sign for Route 15 East at this Y intersection). Go just under 2 miles. **Turn left at entrance to Fort Ethan Allen (first stoplight AFTER Camp Johnson turnoff), which puts you on Barnes Avenue. ***Take 2nd right onto Ethan Allen Avenue. Go 2/10 mile. On left is sign for Elley-Long Music Center (after the Vermont Public Television building on your right). Park behind Elley-Long building.

FROM THE SOUTH: I-89 North to Exit 15. Right off ramp onto Route 15 East. Go 1.3 miles. Follow directions from ** above.

FROM FIVE CORNERS IN ESSEX JUNCTION (intersection of Routes 2A, 15, and 117): Take Route 15 West for 2.3 miles. Turn right at stoplight (note green sign for Civil Defense) into Fort Ethan Allen. This puts you on Barnes Avenue. Follow directions from *** above.

FROM FERRY LANDING IN GRAND ISLE, VT: Travel time between Plattsburgh, NY and Colchester, VT is about 50 minutes, including 12-minute ferry crossing. See www.ferries.com for fares and schedules. From VT ferry landing: Right onto Route 314 South. Bear left at .6 mile, following 314. Go another 1.6 miles and turn right on Route 2 East. Go 13 miles (look up at 3.2 miles to see Mount Mansfield and Camel's Hump; at 5.5 miles is State Park then osprey nests). Take I-89 South to Exit 16. Follow directions from * above.

IMPORTANT! WHEN LEAVING ELLEY-LONG MUSIC CENTER:
To avoid confusion when leaving, turn right out of parking lot (so Elley-Long is on your right) onto Ethan Allen Ave., then left onto Barnes. This brings you to stoplight and intersection of Route 15.

CAUTION FOR I-89 TRAVELERS: IF YOU ARE DRIVING SOUTHBOUND, THERE IS NO EXIT 15!!!
